



How to Open KMZ Files (Project Maps / Barricade Plans) on Your Device

This project includes interactive map files in KMZ format, which can be viewed using Google Earth.

Follow the instructions below based on your device.

For iPhone & iPad (iOS Devices)

- 1. Download Google Earth (free app)**
 - Open the App Store on your device
 - Search for **Google Earth**
 - Download and install the app
 - OR click the 'Google Earth' button on the project updates website
 - 2. Download the KMZ File**
 - From the project website, tap the KMZ file link
 - The file will download to your device (typically in your "Files" app)
 - 3. Open the KMZ File**
 - Open the **Files** app
 - Locate the downloaded KMZ file
 - Tap the file
 - Select **Google Earth** when prompted
 - 4. View the Map**
 - The map will open within Google Earth
 - You can zoom, pan, and tap features to explore project details

For Windows (Desktop/Laptop)

- 1. Download Google Earth Pro (free app/download)**
 - Visit the Google Earth download link on the project website
 - Install **Google Earth Pro for Desktop** (desktop version is superior to the app)
 - 2. Download the KMZ File**
 - Click the KMZ file link on the website
 - Save the file to your computer (Downloads folder is typical)
 - 3. Open the KMZ File**
 - Option 1:
 - Double-click the KMZ file
 - It should automatically open in Google Earth
 - Option 2:
 - Open Google Earth Pro
 - Click **File → Open**
 - Browse to your downloaded KMZ file and select it
 - 4. View the Map**
 - The project map will appear in the "Places" panel
 - Use your mouse to zoom, rotate, and explore the project area

Tips for Best Use

- Ensure Google Earth is fully installed before opening KMZ files
 - Internet connection may be required to load map imagery
 - If the file does not open automatically, try opening it from within Google Earth
