



ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE



April 21st, 2026

Dear Resident,

This notice is to inform you of upcoming temporary access closures along Route 2 due to essential roadway construction as part of MoDOT Project JKU0049 (Route 2 from Harrisonville to La Tour, MO). The project will be managed out of MoDOT’s Lee’s Summit Project Office and constructed by Emery Sapp & Sons, Inc.

There will be two separate and temporary access closures which will sit along Route 2 within Harrisonville. The locations and estimated dates are listed below. During these closures, Route 2 will remain open to traffic but regulated under a pilot car operation. The closures will primarily affect access points from adjacent neighborhoods onto Route 2.

Temporary Access Closure Details:

Closure #1:

Approximately 1.1 miles along Route 2, from the intersection of S. Independence Street and W. South Street to Twin Oaks Drive (across from Harrisonville Church of the Nazarene).

Affected Access Locations:

- S. Lexington St -S. Highland Dr -Eastwood Rd -S. King Ave -S. Edgevale Dr
- S. Halsey Ave -Chapel Dr -Bird Ave -Blueberry Dr -Mission Rd
- Outlook Dr -Meadow Dr -Twin Oaks Dr

Closure #2:

S. Independence Street from S. Commercial Street to the intersection of W. South Street and Route 2.

Affected Access Locations:

- Conoco Gas Station -S. Main St -Bowman St

Estimated Closure Dates:

Closure #1: May 4th & 12th

Closure #2: May 11th & 12th

Traffic Control & Access Information:

Route 2 will remain open during construction with a pilot car operation guiding traffic through the work zone. Access from neighborhood streets onto Route 2 will be temporarily restricted during active construction.

We are aware that Eastwood Rd, which is the back entrance/exit to the high school, is in Closure #1. To minimize disruption, work within Harrisonville will begin after 8:00 AM to allow morning and school traffic to clear. Barricades will be placed at neighborhood entrances along Route 2. These barricades are intended to restrict access from side streets onto Route 2, while still allowing vehicles already traveling on Route 2 to exit into the neighborhoods.

If you need to access Route 2, we recommend doing so west of the S. Independence St/W. South St/Route 2 intersection or east at Twin Oaks Drive, where flaggers will be stationed to assist with traffic flow.

Alternate routes are encouraged, including Route 7 to the north, and Orchard Road or E. Joy Street to the south.

If you are entering Route 2 from a location that remains open, please wait for the pilot car to guide you through the construction. Traffic will be reduced to one lane during paving operations, and it is **CRITICAL** that all vehicles follow the pilot car for the safety of the motorist, the public, and the **workers**.

Construction Phasing:

Construction will begin with Closure #1. Initial paving will occur in the westbound lane moving east, placing a base (“scratch”) course from the 4-way intersection to La Tour. Approximately one week later, crews will return paving in the eastbound lane and will install the final surface layer.


Closure #2 will be implemented during the second phase of work. Access from Orchard Road will remain open during this time; however, alternate routes are strongly encouraged.
